Acts 4:30


Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus."

God's Word & Authority



Hebrews 6:18

God has given both his promise and his oath.

These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us.

As we hold the Word of God in our hands and speak it with our mouths, as we read from the pages of the Bible—the scriptures and verses—they do not lie.

They speak truth.

Because God does not lie, we must believe what He says without doubt.

Doubt leads to disbelief.

James 1:6

"But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind."

From the very beginning in Genesis 3, the devil brought doubt and disbelief. He still uses the same tactics today, through ideas and thoughts.

Thoughts and Questions like:

- Did God really say that?
- I doubt you will get healed;
- God gave you this sickness

or

You are not worthy.





Sickness and aging came into the world due to Adam and Eve's sins.

A sick person is not necessarily sick because of sin in his life but because of sin in the world.

God did not give you this sickness. The devil did. He is the liar, the king of doubt and disbelief.

I am going to doubt my doubts. Let us doubt our doubts.

Doubt and feelings often go hand in hand.

If we rely too much on our feelings, they can rob us of the healing God provides. Many people we pray for say, 'I didn't feel anything.'

But the good news is that healing doesn't come from feelings—it comes from the Word of God.

This **must** be our foundation. If we depend on feelings instead of God's truth, we risk losing the healing, because our faith is built on emotions rather than on His unchanging Word.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.





The Word of God is the greatest weapon we have against satan. It is the answer to sickness; it is more powerful than medication.

I lived on medication for 7 years.

It enabled me to live, but it did not get me healed.

I am not saying for you to give your medication up. What I'm saying is to speak God's word every time you take your medication, knowing God's word will heal you.

It is the confession of the Word of God.

God's Word is not just something we carry in a book; it is held in our hearts and being, and it needs to become what we meditate on and memorise. We speak it out.

Let's speak these healing scriptures out loud.

Exodus 15:26

He said, "If you will listen carefully to the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in his sight, obeying his commands and keeping all his decrees, then I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; for I am the Lord who heals you."

1 Peter 2:24

"He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed.

Isaiah 53:5

But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Psalm 103:2-3

Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases.

Jeremiah 17:14

"Heal me, lord, and I will be healed, save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise."

Authority

Acts 4:10

Let me clearly state to all of you and to all the people of Israel that he was healed by the powerful name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, the man you crucified but whom God raised from the dead.

The authority is in the name of Jesus Christ.

The authority to heal the sick is not in my name or your name. It's not in the pastor's or apostle's authority – but in Jesus' name.

Luke 4:32

And they were astonished at His teaching, for His word was with authority.

God's word is so powerful that it has the authority to free us from whatever sickness or disease we face.


When we see a policeman in uniform, we know he has authority.

We know the police officer has been trained on rules and regulations to uphold the law. He has also been given weapons to enforce the law, such as a gun or a baton or in some countries, you will see them with a long, thick stick.

We all obey his authority when he says stop-we stop.

We go when he says go.

When we read the account of the Roman officer, he also knew what authority is.



When Jesus returned to Capernaum, a Roman officer came and pleaded with him, "Lord, my young servant lies in bed, paralyzed and in terrible pain." Jesus said, "I will come and heal him." But the officer said, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come into my home. Just say the word from where you are, and my servant will be healed. I know this because I am under the authority of my superior officers, and I have authority over my soldiers. I only need to say, 'Go,' and they go, or 'Come,' and they come. And if I say to my slaves, 'Do this,' they do it."

When Jesus heard this, he was amazed. Turning to those who were following him, he said, "I tell you the truth, I haven't seen faith like this in all Israel! And I tell you this, that many Gentiles will come from all over the world—from east and west—and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob at the feast in the Kingdom of Heaven. But many Israelites—those for whom the Kingdom was prepared—will be thrown into outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Then Jesus said to the Roman officer, "Go back home. Because you believed, it has happened." And the young servant was healed that same hour.

Read this over and over: The Roman officer knew what authority is.

Vs. 8

But the officer said, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come into my home. Just say the word from where you are, and my servant will be healed.

I know this because I am under the authority of my superior officers, and I have authority over my soldiers. I only need to say, 'Go,' and they go, or 'Come,' and they come. And if I say to my slaves, 'Do this,' they do it."

Just say the word

Just as a police officer is trained and equipped with weapons to carry out his duty, the Roman officer understood true authority. We, too, have been given authority—our guide is the Holy Spirit, and our weapon is the Word of God. We are continually in training until the day we go home to be with Jesus.

Our authority over demons and sickness comes from speaking the name of Jesus.

It's not my strength!

It's not my ability!

The authority is over the devil and his plans.

The authority is over sickness and disease!

Luke 9:1-2

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Jesus sent the twelve disciples. Jesus sends you equipped with the Holy Spirit and the word of God to go into the marketplace and take authority over sickness and diseases.

Session 2

Holy Spirit







Acts 2:1-4

On the day of Pentecost, all the believers were meeting together in one place. Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting.

Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

The Holy Spirit is undoubtedly the most significant life transformation you will ever experience.

Nothing compares to the Holy Spirit.

I'm married, and I love my wife and children. While cars and boats are nice, the most influential moment in my life was when I was filled with the Holy Spirit. It totally changed me.

We are born of the Spirit, worshipping in and through the Spirit.

We receive gifts from the Spirit and pray in the Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is our partner, guide, and helper.

Miracles occur when we partner with the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit takes ordinary people and allows them to do extraordinary things.

The Holy Spirit gives you gifts for God's Kingdom, extending His rule and reign over cities and nations; it allows you to show the world the love of Jesus, to go into the world where you have influence, to heal the sick, and to show His Love for all people.

1 Corinthians 12:7-11

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by [a]the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

Holy Spirit will equip you and give you gifts, and you will do things no one else can!





Now let's look at: The Four Gifts of the Holy Spirit.

- 1. Word of Knowledge
- 2.Faith
- 3. Gift of Healing
- 4. Working of Miracles

1 Corinthians 12:7-9

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit.

Word of Knowledge

1 Corinthians 12:8
...for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit.

This knowledge means to have an understanding or insight given to us not through human means, but through the Holy Spirit. It's received directly from Him, enabling us to minister effectively to those around us. At times, we might suddenly understand situations, circumstances, details, or needs that others are facing. This knowledge is a way to bring people into an encounter with Christ.

To receive this knowledge, we need to spend time with God, seeking to hear His voice. It's in those moments of stillness that we are able to listen and hear what He is saying.

The first time I call someone, they don't know my voice, and I don't know theirs, but after we build a relationship, we know who we are talking to as soon as they speak.

It is the same with God – as we build closer relationship with Him, we come to recognise when He is speaking.

Faith

1 Corinthians 12:9

...to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,

Mark 9:23.

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

It's easy to say we believe in God, but do we believe what God says? Believing "all things" means all things; nothing is impossible with God, so

let's believe in things beyond our understanding.

I believe you will be healed, can you believe with me and put our faith together?

2 Corinthians 4:18

So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever. Faith believes in the extraordinary, trusting in supernatural intervention. We often feel self-sufficient, questioning the need for faith until we face moments of desperation.

In those times of confusion and uncertainty, our faith is tested. Immediate results may not come after taking a leap of faith, and we might wait before seeing God's hand at work. Yet, this waiting can deepen our faith. By staying patient and steadfast, we unlock the profound possibilities that faith can bring into our lives.

God is faithful.

Hebrews 11:1

Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see

Faith's evidence rests not on speculation but on confidence in a God who sees what we cannot see.

It rests on trust in the reliability of every promise that God utters
By faith, we give our hearts to Jesus, and that's our first step of faith. We must
believe just as we said yes to Jesus for our salvation. By Faith, we say yes to
Jesus for our healing.

Gift of Healing

1 Corinthians 12:9

to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,

You don't need to be in a full-time healing ministry to operate in the Gifts of Healing. It's all about what Jesus accomplished on the cross, dying for us to live in the right relationship with God, where Jesus bore our sins in His Body and by His wounds, we are healed. His promise of the Holy Spirit is to show the world His power through you.

1 Peter 2:24

"He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed

It's the power of the Holy Spirit—the name of Jesus. One of the most important lessons I can give you is that it's not about you. It is all about Jesus. You can lay your hands on someone and not see instant healing; and you can lay your hands on another person, and you will see them healed.

It's all about Jesus and the Spirit of God being able to manifest Himself however He wants to. This takes the pressure off us trying to achieve something that is impossible or in our own strength; it's just being obedient and a vessel that Jesus can use.







Jesus showed us how to live life here on earth. He was fully human, and his ministry started after he was baptized in the Jordan River. The anointing Jesus has is for us, too. Jesus made it possible to do what He did: heal the sick and set those who are demon-possessed free.

Acts 10:38

And you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

John 14:12

"I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

Jesus sent His disciples out to heal the people in His name and to cast out demons.

Matthew 10:1

Jesus called his twelve disciples together and gave them authority to cast out evil[a] spirits and to heal every kind of disease and illness.

The gift of healing varies among different people. We are all uniquely made, and we hear from God in different ways. I encourage you to nurture your gifting, stand with those who have this gift, learn from them, and allow the Holy Spirit to train and equip you.

God will bring the right people into your life.

Remember, it doesn't work the same way for everyone.

The Bible makes it clear that we should call for the elders to pray for us.

There are times when we lose hope, and we need others to stand with us, especially when we are sick.







James 5:14

Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord.

I believe when we have communion, it is a great time to bring our bodies to Jesus.


The healing that Jesus purchased for us when He allowed His body to be broken by the beaten.

Acts 19:11


God gave Paul the power to perform unusual miracles.

Hebrews 2:4

And God confirmed the message by giving signs and wonders and various miracles and gifts of the Holy Spirit whenever he chose.

- Signs: pointers to God's supernatural activity.
- Wonders: works intended to create a sense of awe and amazement.
- Miracles: mighty acts that reveal God's power.
- Healings: Healing all diseases, and evil spirits were removed.

When people heard and saw what Jesus was doing, multitudes came. People need to know that Jesus loves them and wants to heal them. The Holy Spirit will confirm the works. We are the ones whom God has handpicked and entrusted to show the world.

And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with one accord in Solomon's Porch.


